The Good Landlord Charter is a voluntary scheme landlords in Greater Manchester can join.





To be a member, homes must meet the legal standards for renting. Scheme members will agree to go beyond this and meet higher standards. We will give them our support to do this.



Landlords will be able to say they have signed up to the Good Landlord Charter. This tells people who are looking to rent that the Landlord believes in higher standards.



The Good Landlord Charter is for all landlords. It does not matter how many homes they rent out, from 1 or 2 private rented homes to councils or housing associations with 1,000s of tenants.


